07:00–13:00 Field Trip – (Kpong Irrigation Scheme -ASUTSUARE)

Kpong Irrigation Scheme at Asutsuare is in the Shai-Osudoku District of the Greater Accra Region of Ghana . The scheme is 2 hours drive from Accra city and shares boundary with Volta and Eastern Regions respectively. Asatsuare is the largest irrigation scheme in Ghana, and it is noted first for sugarcane production in the mid 60's, currently the scheme is famous in rice production and processing with capacity for two crops in a year. In addition, the scheme has vegetable and aqua culture production activities, and boast of being the largest privately owned banana planatation in the West Africa region. The Scheme's water source is from the Kpong Hydro dam at Akuse.
